# DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

- For those enrolled in the 3 and 4 year old programs, drop off will begin at 8:55 AM.
- For those enrolled in the 2s program or Kindergarten Bridge, drop off begins at 9:10 AM.
- Please expect that the first few weeks will run slowly, as some children may have a hard time leaving their parent/provider.

# DROP-OFF POLICIES & PROCEDURES

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DRIVERS – How can you help?

- Have your preschooler seated behind the driver.
- Have your child prepared to exit the vehicle.
- Be courteous and patient. (Sometimes children have a hard time leaving parent/provider.)
- DRIVE SLOWLY AND CAREFULLY!!

WALKERS – Please:

- Arrive by 8:55. If you arrive after 8:55, please wait until the drop-off loop is clear of cars before walking down.
- Wait with your child on the sidewalk by the playground until a teacher arrives.
- Please do not walk your child into school.

# FOOD & BIRTHDAY TREATS

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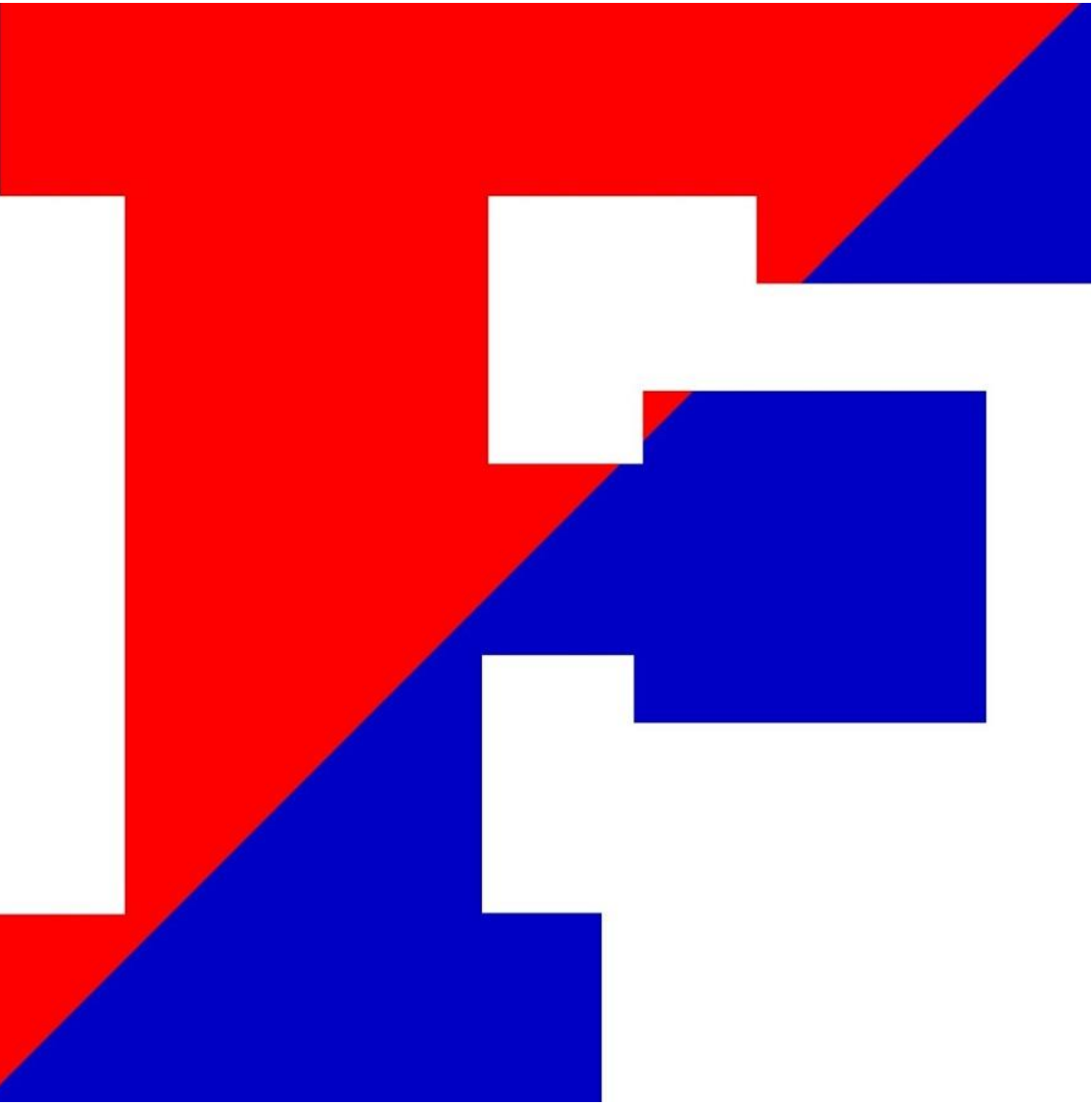
- Will receive a copy of our food policy from your child's teacher
